B-3. Exhibit B Summary

Exhibit B establishes:

2. **No part of the docket shows any registration order** or related designation.
3. The **sentencing record, PSI, and docket** all align to confirm the same conclusion: **no lawful duty to register ever existed.**

This exhibit supports the foundational position that Pennsylvanian law did not impose any registration requirement upon Petitioner at the time of sentencing.
