C-4. Relevance to Petition

This exhibit demonstrates:

1. **Ongoing harm** — Petitioner continues to be labeled publicly as a sexual offender.
 2. **Continuing enforcement** — PSP requires reporting periods and updates.
 3. **Ex Post Facto violation** — PSP is applying post-sentence punitive obligations retroactively.
 4. **Lack of judicial basis** — No lawful order supports this classification.
 5. **Foundation for injunctive relief** — The Court is empowered to strike unlawful agency actions.
