Hello Lea,

Just seeing if there's anything new with the case? We seemed to have an issue connecting with each other back in March when I emailed you.

Another thing...

I'm either super paranoid or there is an app or something out there that is tracking people on the registry and notifying people when they are nearby me. I've just noticed certain things when out in public that makes me think this is true. I've looked online for answers but haven't been finding anything. Here are experiences that make me believe this:

- The winter before last I left a friends house and was walking to the car of another friend I was with who was still inside the other friends place. As I crossed the street there was a man and woman walking pushing a stroller. As I got closer the woman pulled out her phone, looked at it, looked up towards my direction and they stopped walking. As I passed them I heard the man say let's just keep going. The woman said I'm calling the police. I did not have the keys to the car so I stopped at the drivers side of the car to wait for my friend to come. I heard the lady give my full name, a description of what I was wearing and what I was doing (standing next to the car) to whomever she was on the phone with which I'm assuming was 911. My friend came out and we drove off. No clue what happened after that.

- Last summer I was walking home in Friendship and there was a little girl walking on the sidewalk heading my way. She stopped walking, looked at her phone, started to cry and run. As she ran past me I heard her phone saying RUN RUN RUN and making this awful sound.

- Last summer I was standing outside of Aldi's on Penn Ave waiting for my ride to pick me up and there was this older lady sitting in her car. I noticed her phone pointing in my direction. I'm thinking she was on the phone with 911 because I heard her say "he's just standing there" and that she wasn't going to get out of her car. My ride arrived and we left. As we drove past her parked car she continued to follow with her phone so I can only guess that she was recording. I happened to give her the finger and eyeball her as we drove past making it known I was aware she was watching me.

- Yesterday, I was walking downtown on Liberty Ave and I passed two what appeared to be younger females. As I got closer they both looked at their phones and as I passed I heard the one say "don't look at that guy."

- Yesterday, also while walking downtown I noticed a rather large number of people look at their phones as I approached or passed them then looked up at me. One lady ran across the street as I got closer.

There are several other incidents that I could describe but I'll just leave it with the above. I would love to know how this tracking is being done and I can only assume it through Google or cell phone provider. I'm not living like this. The first 8 years after being placed on that registry I became Agoraphobic and rarely left the house. I couldn't even open the front door to check the mailbox and I feel like I'm heading back in that direction. I don't even take my dog out for walks anymore
