Jim,

A few developments:

Last week, the Commonwealth Court denied the AG's office's request for a stay in a case I have that has such similar issues to your situation that consolidation may ultimately be beneficial. I plan to wait until the AG files its answer to advise one way or the other.

We're keeping our eyes on the Com v. Lacombe and Com. v. Torsilieri. They are both before the PA Supreme Court and raise the question of the applicability of SORNA II to Megan's Law I registrants.

PASC still no clear answers on whether Megan's Law II survived after Megan's Law III was enacted, but I expect that we'll have a ruling from the Commonwealth Court before that issue is clarified.
