November 21, 2025 to November 30, 2025

A list of approved registration sites is enclosed. It is recommended that you contact the registration site prior to arrival to confirm their hours of operation and a registering official is available to assist you.

If you fail to report to an approved site within the dates listed above, you are in violation of 18 Pa. C.S., Chapter 49, Section 4915.1 or 4915.2 and may be subject to prosecution. You are reminded to review your completed form prior to leaving the site. If error(s) are found, please request the official to make the correction(s) prior to leaving the site. *Non-incarcerated Sexually Violent Predators and Sexually Violent Delinquent Children are reminded of their requirement to attend monthly counseling sessions. **Driver's license, vehicle registrations, professional licenses, passports, etc. must be brought to the registration site if your offense was committed on or after 12/20/2012. ***Any changes to registration information must be reported within three business days.
